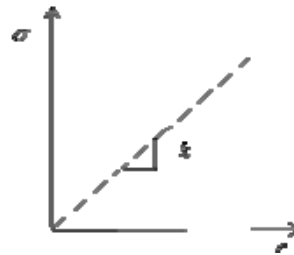

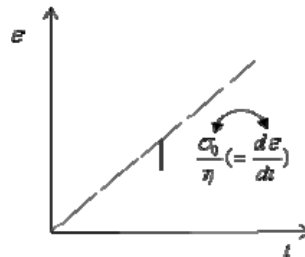
$$k = \frac{\sigma}{\varepsilon}$$



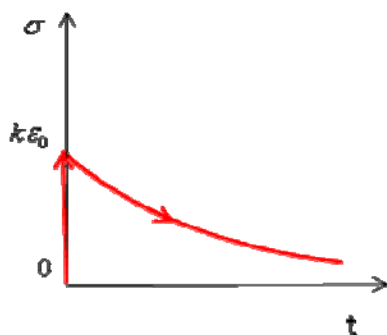
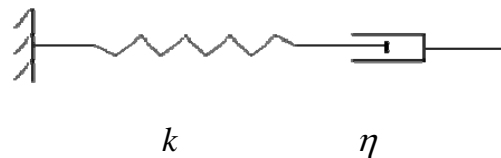
- Dashpot



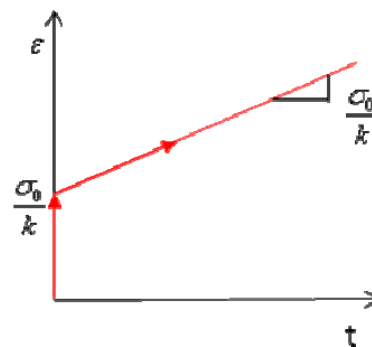
$$\eta = \frac{\sigma}{\dot{\varepsilon}} \quad (\text{viscous damping})$$



- Maxwell model



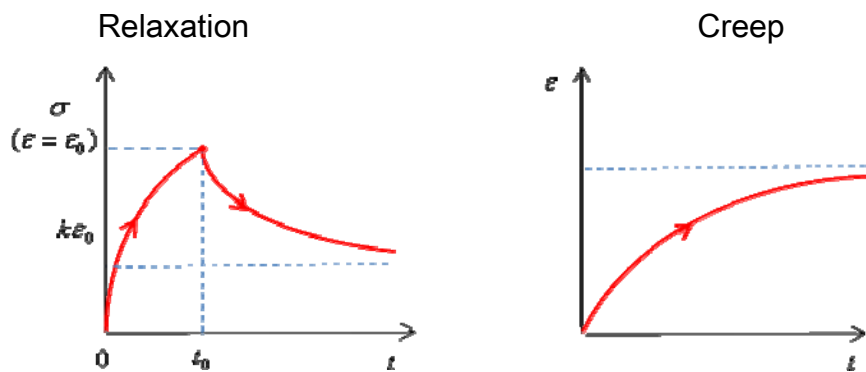
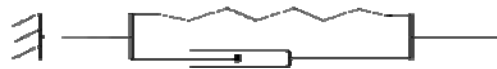
$$\sigma = \frac{k\eta\varepsilon_0}{\eta + kt}$$



$$\varepsilon = \frac{\sigma}{k} + \frac{\sigma_0}{\eta}t$$

- Relaxation : apply initial strain & hold it → stress released
- Creep : apply initial stress & maintain it → deformation occurs

● Kelvin-Voigt model



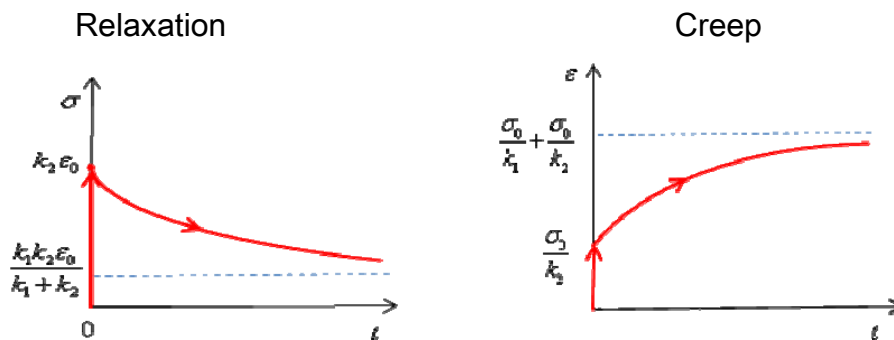
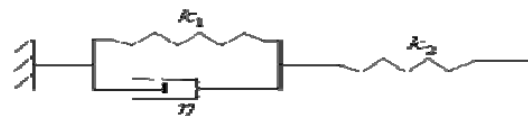
$$\sigma = \frac{k \epsilon_0}{1 - e^{-kt/\eta}}$$

$$(\sigma_{t=\infty} = k \epsilon_0)$$

$$\epsilon = \frac{\sigma_0}{k} (1 - e^{-kt/\eta})$$

$$\epsilon_{t=\infty} = \sigma_0 / k$$

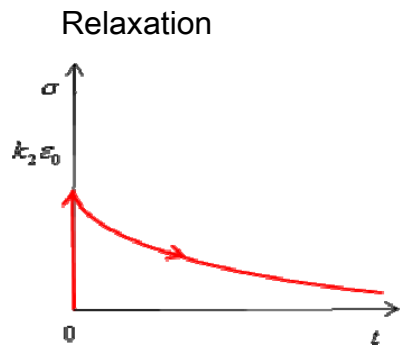
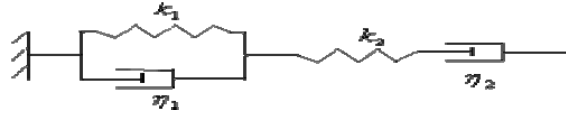
● Generalized Kelvin



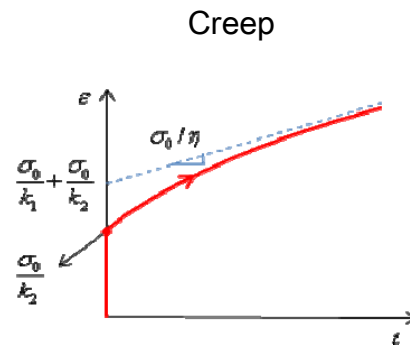
$$\sigma = \frac{k_1 k_2 \epsilon_0}{k_1 + k_2 (1 - e^{-k_1 t / \eta})}$$

$$\epsilon = \frac{\sigma_0}{k_2} + \frac{\sigma_0}{k_1} (1 - e^{-k_1 t / \eta})$$

- Burger model :
(Kelvin – Voigt + Maxwell)



$$\sigma = \frac{\varepsilon_0 k_1 k_2 \eta_2}{k_1 \eta_2 + k_1 k_2 t + k_2 \eta_2 (1 - e^{-k_1 t / \eta_1})}$$



$$\varepsilon = \left(\frac{\sigma_0}{k_2} + \frac{\sigma_0 t}{\eta_2} \right) + \frac{\sigma_0}{k_1} (1 - e^{-k_1 t / \eta_1})$$
