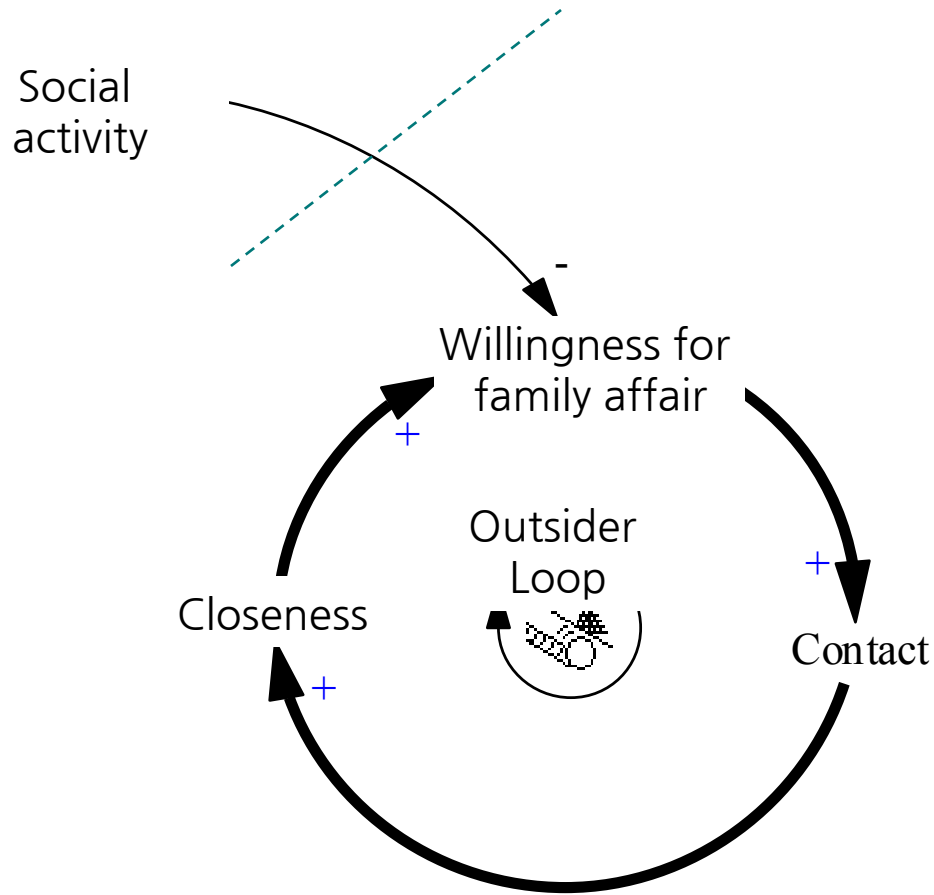

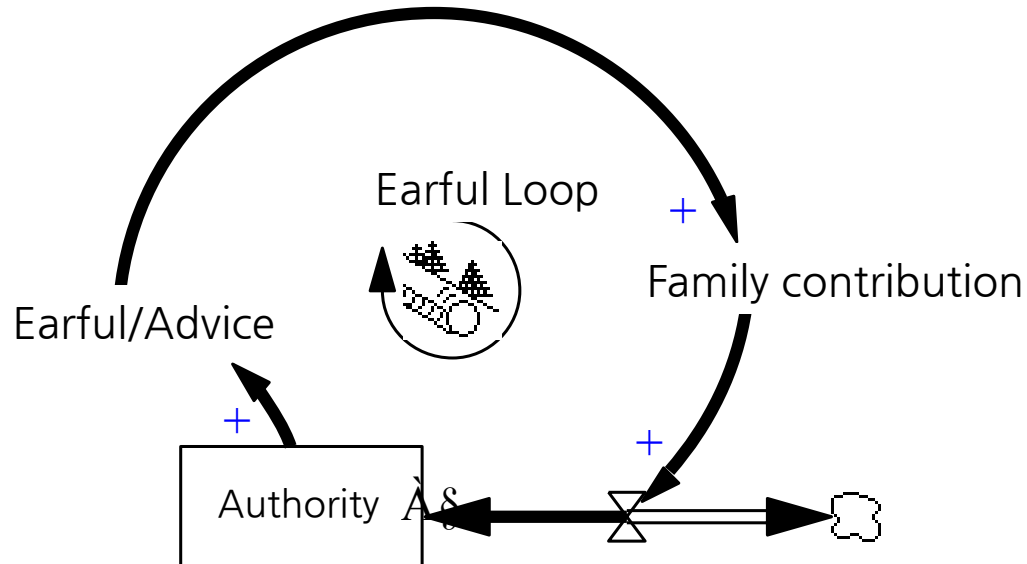
Feedback 1: Outsider (왕따) Loop



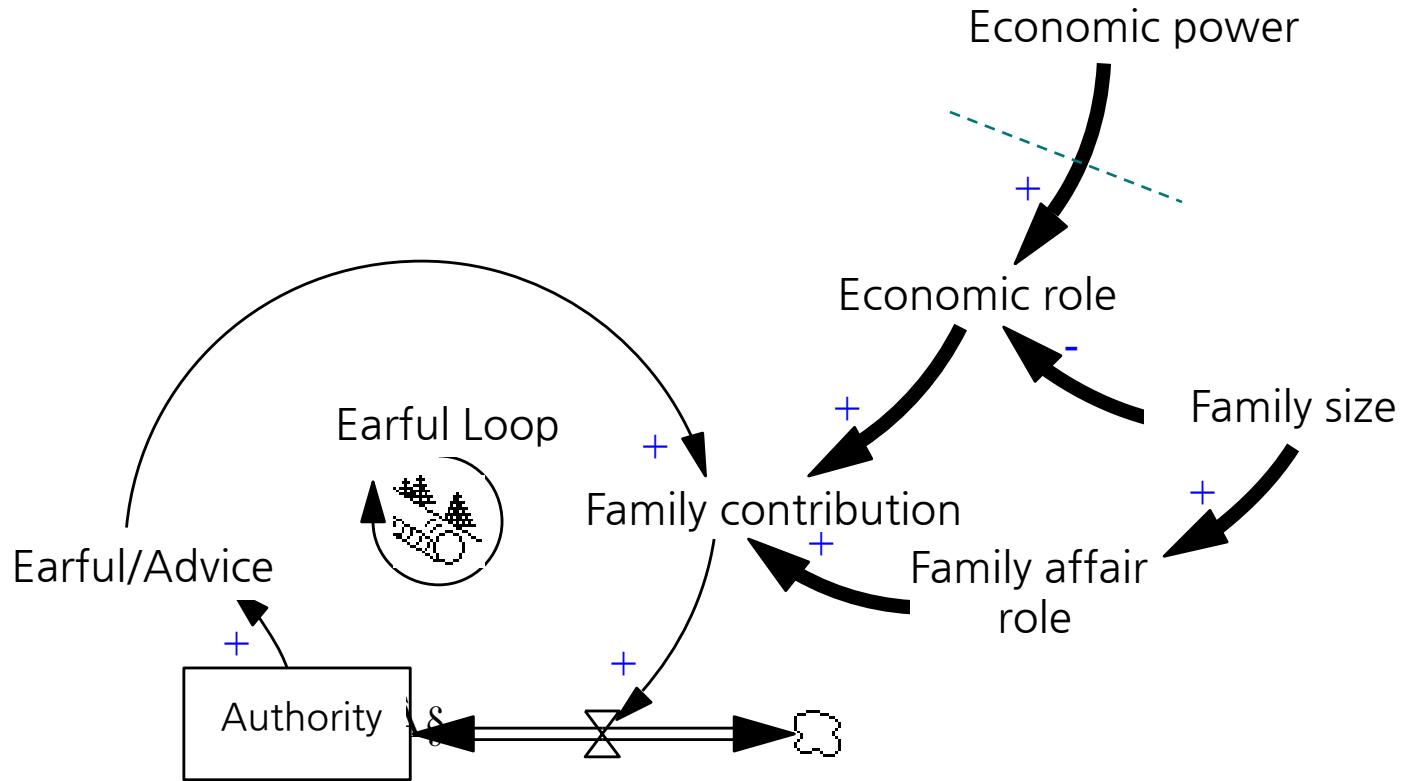
Feedback 2: Earful Loop

Never winning game (원래되지 않는 게임) ...



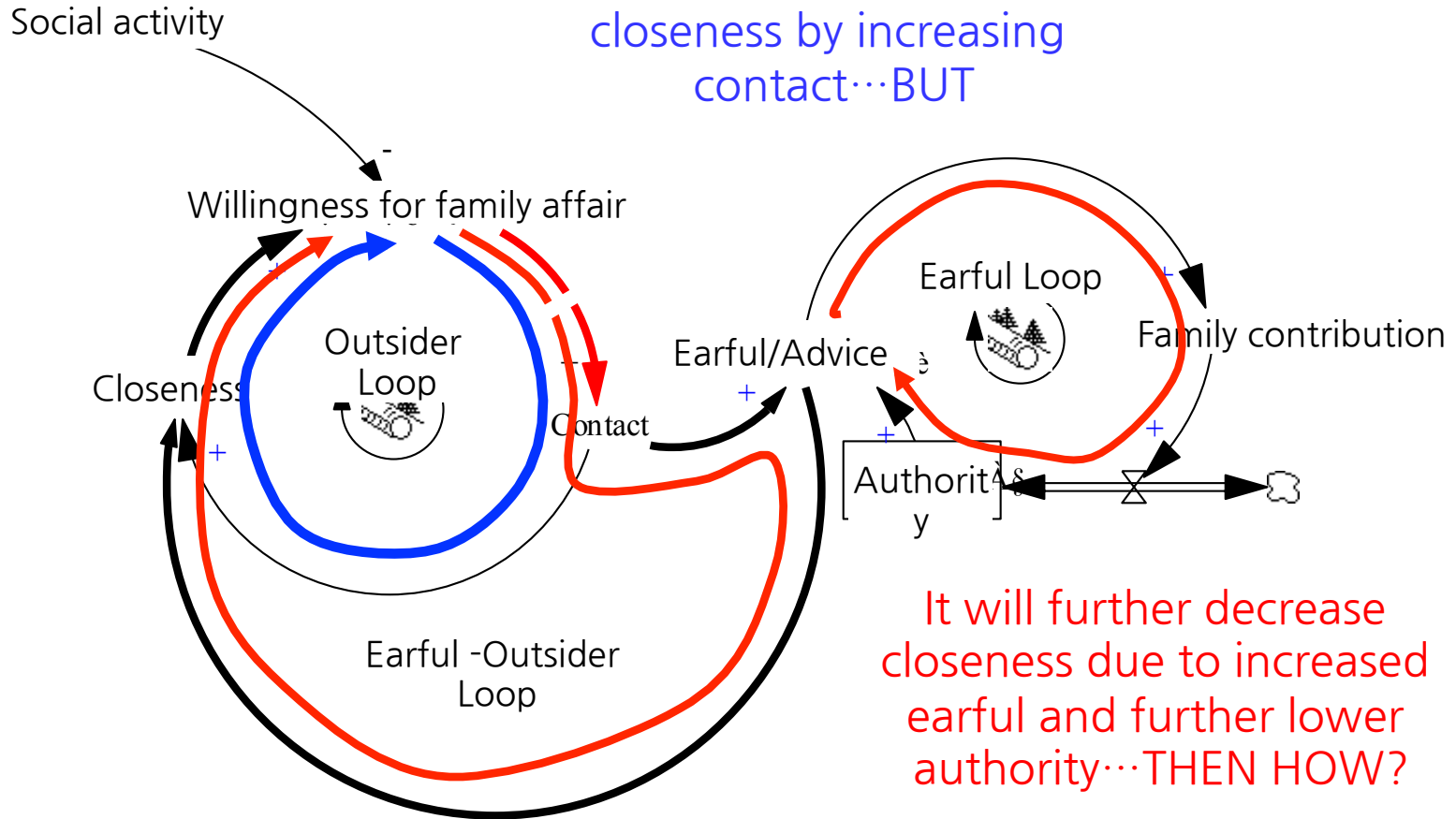

Accordingly...

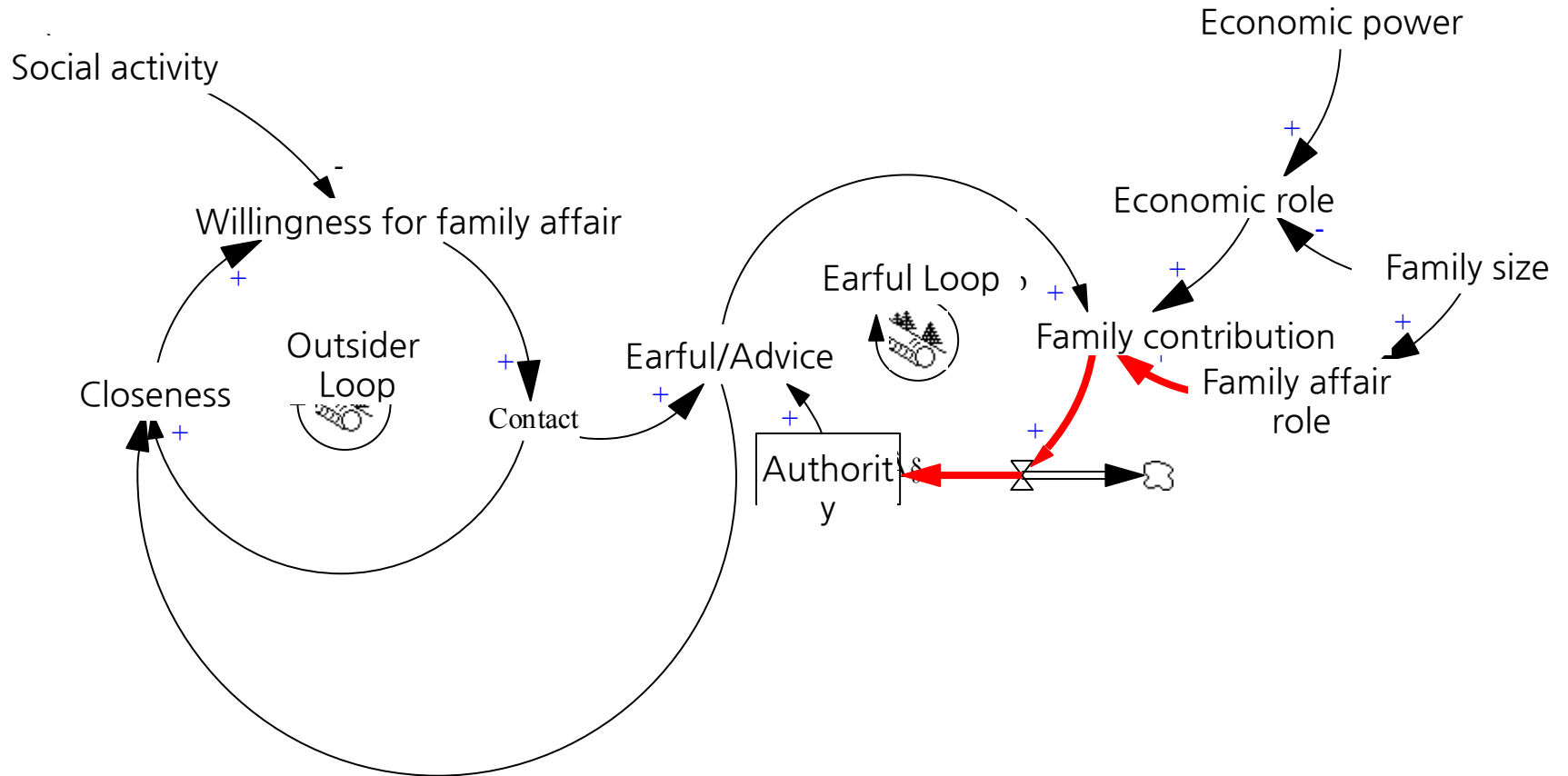
Solution 1: Try to be away from family members for the time being
